This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and sets out the steps we have taken to ensure that our business as well as our supply chains are free from slavery and human trafficking during the financial year ending 31/03/2018.

Bridgnorth Aluminium Ltd is committed to preventing slavery and human trafficking occurring in any of its corporate activities, as well as seeking to ensure that our supply chains are also free from such practices.

Bridgnorth Aluminium Ltd, situated in Bridgnorth, Shropshire is a manufacturer of aluminium flat rolled products. We are owned by Viohalco Group with UACJ also a minority shareholder. We remain our own legal entity within the UK for reporting purposes. Bridgnorth Aluminium employ 415 people at its site in Bridgnorth.

Our Anti-Slavery Policy reflects our commitment to implementing and enforcing effective procedures and controls to minimise the risks of human trafficking and other modern slavery practices infiltrating our business operations or supply chains, and to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business activities and relationships.

Our policies have been developed in consultation with our recognised trade union and employee representative bodies.

We ensure that our suppliers are aware of our policies and take appropriate measures to ensure that our suppliers adhere to the same high standards.
